Observe the following notes for handling the positioning system and controller:

All commissioning work of the positioning system and controller may only be carried out by qualified technicians.

When commissioning the positioning system, observe that collisions with customer equipment are excluded. Observe the action radius of the positioning system when moving the system.

Make sure, that the positioning system ist functioning and error-free.

Pay attention to a careful handling of electronic components. Connecting and disconnecting connectors only in the de-energized condition.

Route the cables in such a way that they do not pass through the action zone of the connected devices and people do not get caught in them. Also note the permissible bending radius of cables.









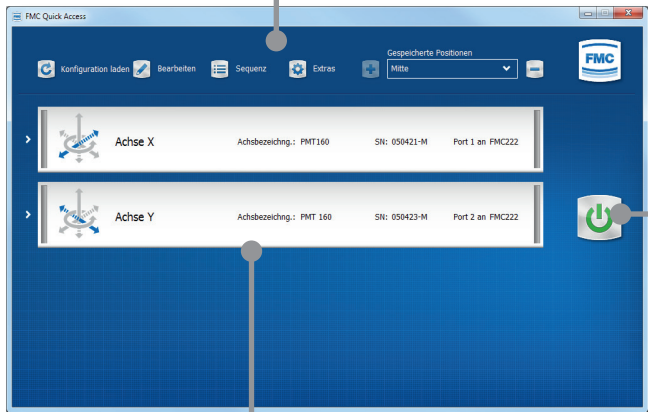
Observe the following requiremenets for installing the software FMC Quick Access:

- ✓ Your computer has the operating system Windows (higher or equal to Windows XP SP2).
- ✓ The following products are available:
 - positioning system
 - controller of the FMC200 series
 - USB and axis connection cable
 - mains adapter
 - controller software FMC Quick Access and files from FTP server

Also pay attention to the information in the detailed documents of the positioning system, controller and software.

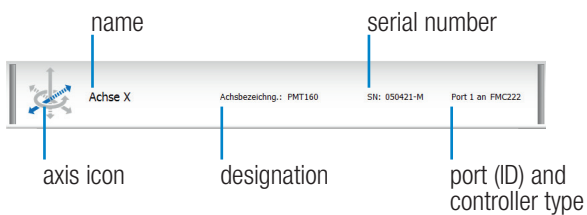

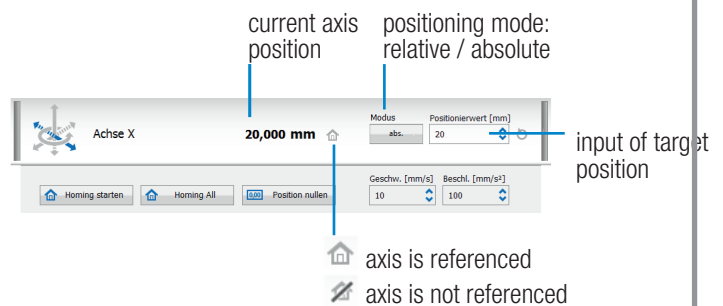

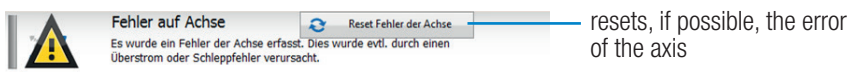

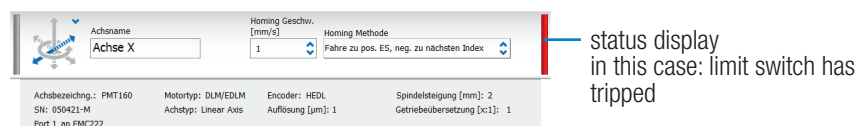
Axis is connectect and without error

Prepare hardware and software

1. Connect the cables of the supplied positioning system to the corresponding connections on the FMC controller. Therefore, pay attention to the labeling on the cables.
2. Connect the FMC controller to the mains adapter (power port) and connect the mains adapter to the power supply.
3. Switch on the mains adapter. The LED on the FMC controller lights up:
 - ⇒ blue LED lights up: Gerät ist störungsfrei
 - ⇒ red LED lights up: es gibt eine Störung, siehe FAQ in der Bedienungsanleitung des Controllers
4. If you are using a FMC link cable, then continue at [Install FMC Quick Access](#).
5. Connect the computer to the USB interface of the controller (PC port).
6. By default, the USB driver is installed automatically. If not, you will need to download the USB driver from the FTP server and install it manually.
 - ⇒ FTP:\Backup\USB Driver

Install FMC Quick Access

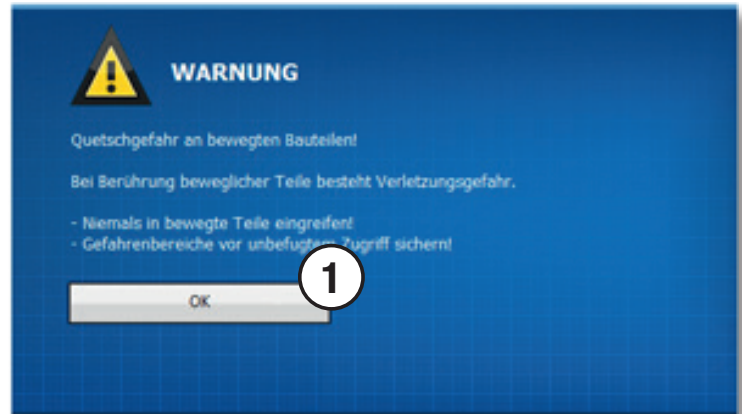
After successful driver installation, you can install the FMC Quick Access software. The installation file can be found on our FTP server:

Start FMC Quick Access

1. Start FMC Quick Access.

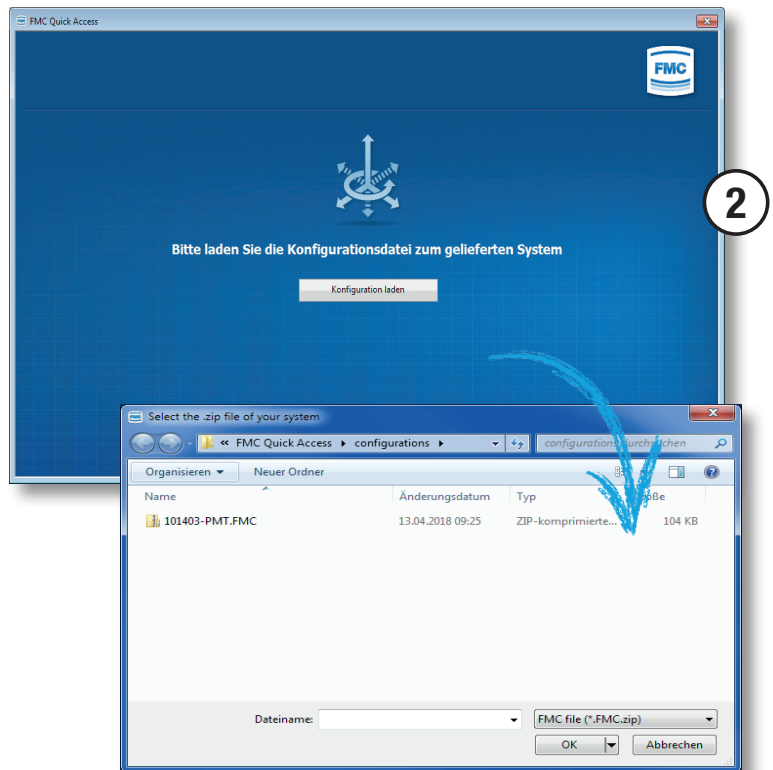
The program starts with a warning.
Confirm this with OK.



2. Click on the button **Load configuration**.

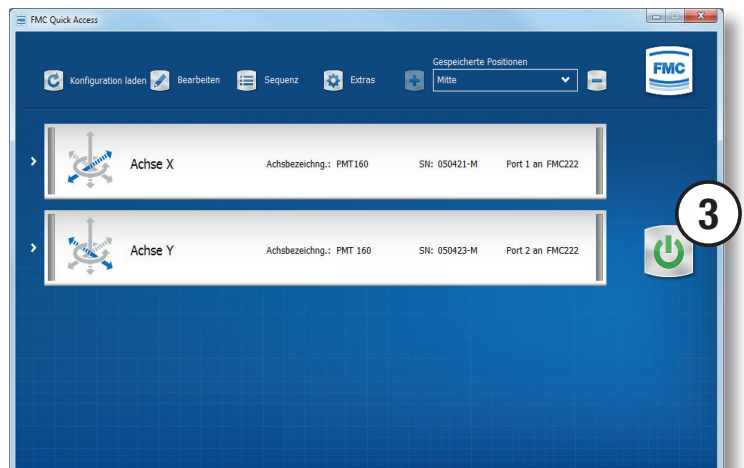
Select the configuration file (.FMC.zip) from the FTP server:

⇒ FTP:\Backup\FMC Quick Access



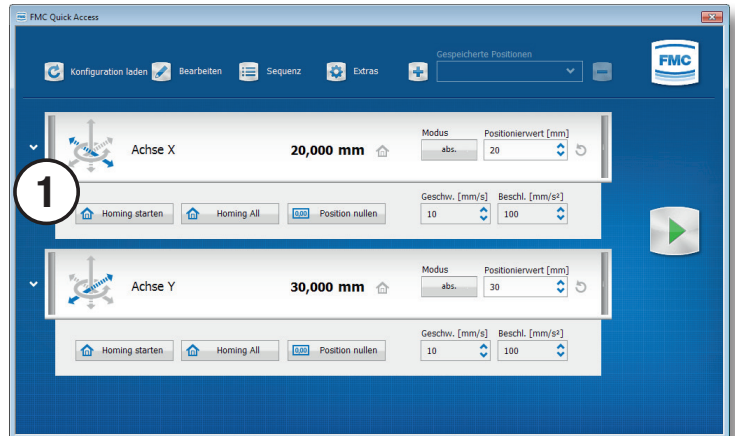
3. Click on the green **start button**.

⇒ The connection to the controller is established.

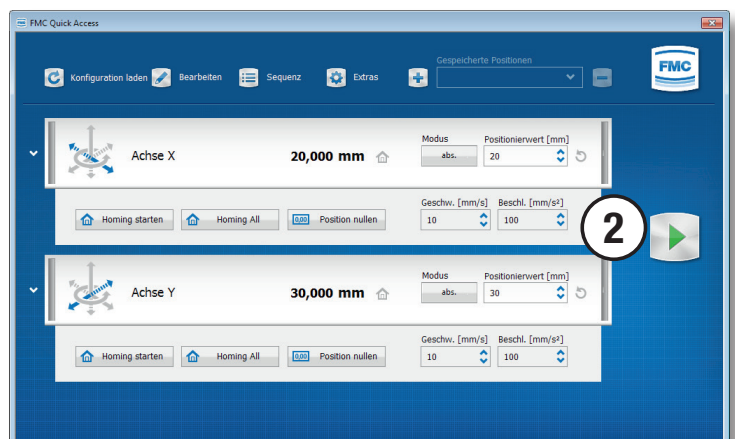


Reference and move the positioning system

1. Click on the arrow to the left of the axis.
Click on the [button Start homing](#) or [Homing all](#).
⇒ The respective axes are referenced one after the other.

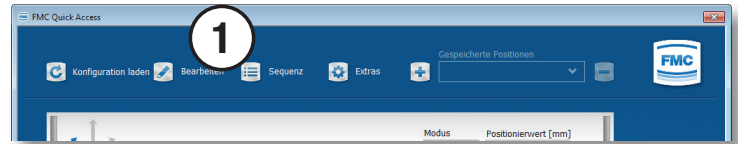


2. After successful referencing, the axes can be moved.
Enter a position value for the respective axes, choose the positioning mode absolute or relative as well as the speed and the acceleration.
Click on the green [play button](#) for positioning.

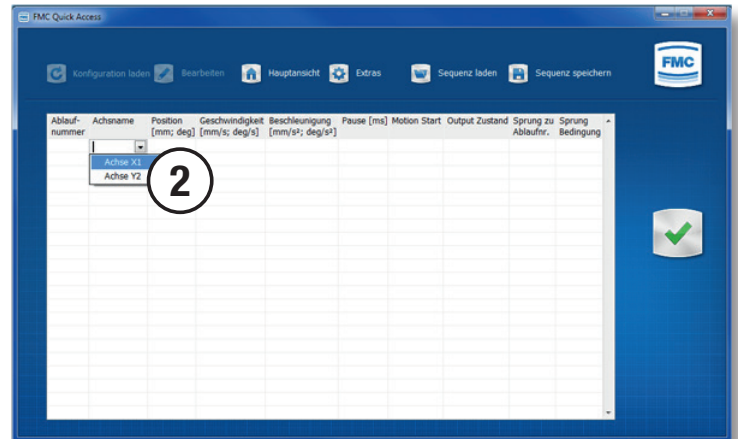


Create a sequential positioning sequence

1. Click on the button Sequence.



2. Select the respective axis via the selection field in the column Axis name.



3. Enter the remaining values in the respective columns.

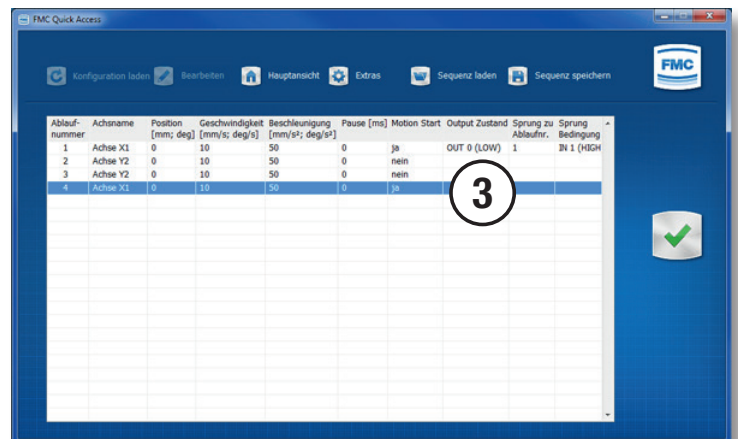


Sequential positioning sequences only allow absolute positioning.

If you select the command yes for Motion Start, the motion of all axes will be executed and a jump to the next sequence will not take place until the motion is completed.

If you select the command no for Motion Start, the traversing parameters are set, but no movement takes place.

Output state and jump condition are controller dependent.



4. Save the current sequence with the button Save Sequence. Select the file path.



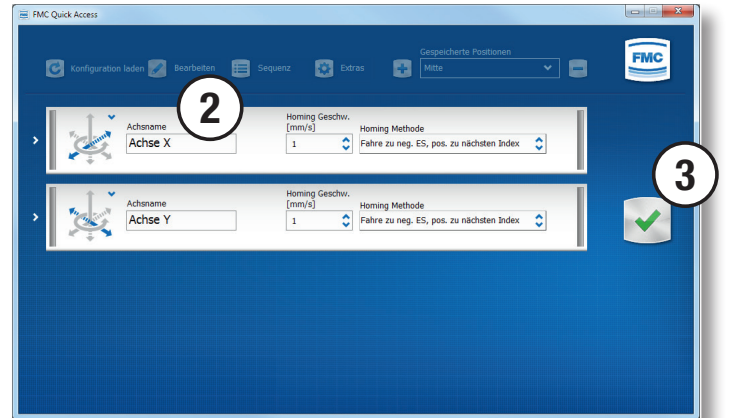
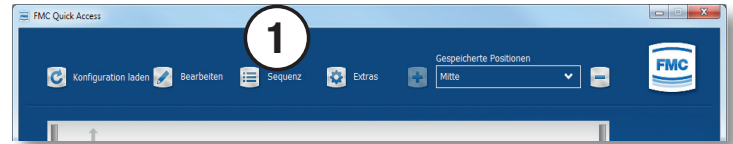
5. With the button Load Sequence, saved positioning sequences can be selected.

Change axis name and axis icon

Change axis name

In the menu Edit you can change the name of the respective axes.

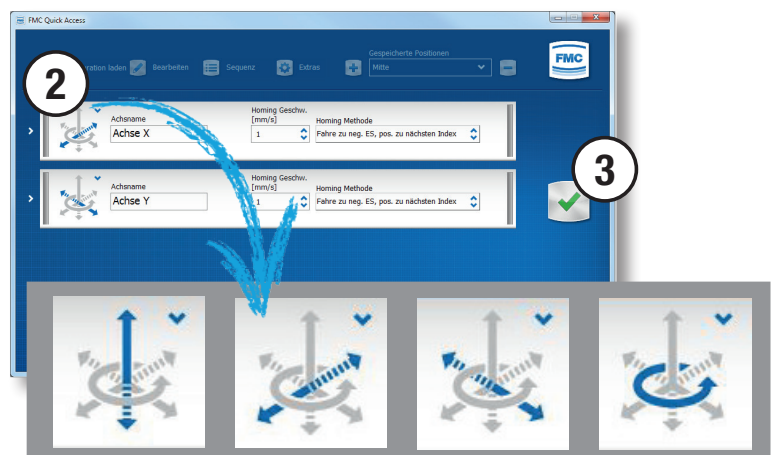
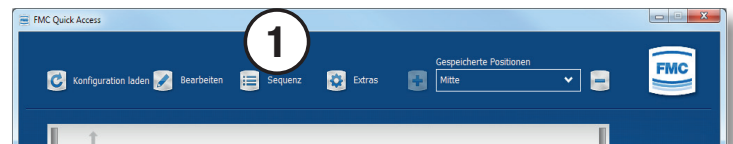
1. Click on the [button Edit](#).
2. Enter the new name of the axis in the input field.
3. Confirm your change with the green [confirm button](#).



Change axis icon

In the menu Edit you can change the icon of the respective axes.

1. Click on the [button Edit](#).
2. Click on the blue arrow to the right of the axis icon and select the desired icon.
3. Confirm your change with the green [confirm button](#).



Information

The menu Extras provides contact information and the option to change the software language.

1. Click on the **button Extras**.
2. Select German or English as language for the software.
3. Confirm your change with the green **confirm button**.
